Please allow up to 5 business days for delivery of your ballot through the U.S. Postal Service.

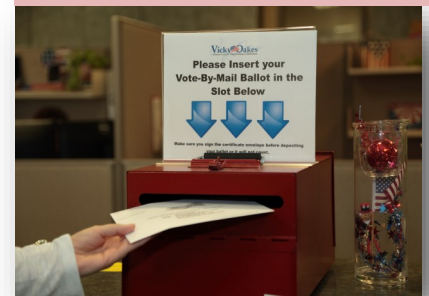
Request your mail ballot early and return your ballot so that it reaches the Elections Office by 7 PM on election day.

## ELECTION DAY VOTERS

General Election - November 6<sup>th</sup> - Polls Open 7 AM to 7 PM
